Guidelines for Applicants

Who needs to be registered?

If you conduct an auction of land or business, in the course of your business as a land agent or on behalf of another land agent, you must be registered as an auctioneer.

Am I eligible for registration?

To qualify for registration as an auctioneer you must be registered (or qualify to register) as a land agent or sales representative and in addition hold the qualification listed below:

A Statement of Attainment showing satisfactory completion of, or status granted in, the following units of competency conferred by a Registered Training Organisation registered to deliver the units from the *CPP07 Property Services Training Package*:

CPPDSM4004A - Conduct auction; and
CPPDSM4019A - Prepare for auction and complete sale.

Or

A Statement of Attainment showing satisfactory completion of, or status granted in, the following units of competency conferred by a Registered Training Organisation registered to deliver the units from the *PRD01 Property Development and Management Training Package*:

PRDRE26A - Conduct property sale by auction

If you believe that you have other qualifications and/or experience equivalent to this unit of competency, you should discuss the recognition of prior learning process with a Registered Training Organisation.

How do I apply?

If you are not already registered as a land agent or sales representative, you can apply for your auctioneer's registration at the same time as for your land agent or sales representative's registration (see the Guideline for a Land Agent Registration or Guideline for a Sales Representative Registration for more information).

If you currently hold a registration as a land agent or sales representative you can contact Consumer and Business Services on 131 882 or visit our Adelaide office to have an application form created for you. The application form will then need to be checked, signed and lodged with the appropriate supporting documentation

What information do I need to provide to complete an application?

Fees

The application fee of \$116.00.

Note: this fee is not charged if applying for registration as a land agent or sales representative at the same time as for a auctioneer's registration - refer to the appropriate Land Agent or Sales Representative Guidelines for the full fee schedule.

Evidence you meet the qualification requirement

You must attach a copy of your qualification.
