

National Restricted Electrical Licence

Guidelines for Applicants

Who needs to be registered?

This restricted electrical workers registration allows the disconnection and reconnection of existing fixed wired equipment (connected to a supply of up to 1000 volts), while observing and maintaining the safety of the working environment.

The work performed includes:

- identifying point of isolation;
- isolating equipment;
- disconnecting the equipment;
- determination of the electrical characteristics of the equipment;
- selecting the replacement equipment;
- reconnecting the equipment;
- testing the equipment for operation and safety.

However, the registration does not permit you to perform electrical maintenance, faultfinding, installation, rewiring, alterations or additions to any electrical equipment or fixed wiring.

Am I eligible for a registration?

You are entitled to obtain an electrical workers restricted registration if you hold the required qualifications.

How do I apply?

What information do I need to provide to complete an application?
