Liquor Licensing Act 1997 - Right to make submissions in relation to application for small venue licence - Section 77A

If an application for, or in relation to, a small venue licence has been advertised under this Part, any person may, by notice in the prescribed form lodged with the Commissioner at least 7 days before the day appointed for the hearing of the application, make submissions to the Commissioner in respect of the application.

The Commissioner must have regard to any submissions made under section 77A.

The Commissioner has the discretion to call for further submissions to be made in relation to a particular application; or to call a hearing to allow the applicant to introduce evidence or make representations.
