For the purpose of licensing for any/all of the following:

- Crowd or Venue Control
- General Guarding
- Body Guarding
- Guarding with a Dog
- Guarding with a Firearm
- Monitoring Centre Operations
- Security Systems Work
- Security Systems Work (Sales and Advice Only)

All qualifications must be in the full legal name of the applicant. If you are intending to also operate as a business/body corporate, refer to the Business Criteria fact sheet for additional training requirements.

Crowd or Venue Control – (Employee)

with completion of the following units of competency:

No qualification required. Relevant training to be provided by employer.

Guarding with a Firearm – (Employee)

This category is only valid when used in conjunction with a current, appropriately endorsed, firearms licence (H6) issued by the South Australian Police. On application you will be required to complete a statement declaring that you hold or intend to hold a H6 category firearms licence.
