

Application for a Wholesale Liquor Merchant's Licence Questionnaire

This questionnaire is designed to inform the licensing authority whether an application satisfies the requirements of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997, and to assist with the application process.

Some of the important criteria to be met include:

- Liquor must not be sold to a purchaser (other than a liquor merchant) in an aggregate quantity of less than 4.5 litres.
- At least 90 percent of the licensee's gross turnover from the sale of liquor in each assessment period (excluding sales of liquor to the licensee's own employees and sale for the delivery of liquor outside Australia) must be derived from the sale of liquor to merchants.

Please note that your responses will be checked by law enforcement agencies. If it is found that you have failed to disclose information required, or have provided false or misleading information in your application, you may be subject to criminal prosecution, disciplinary action and/or licence cancellation.
