## Fingerprinting Instructions

The Liquor and Gambling Commissioner, for the purpose of determining whether a person is fit and proper in respect of an application under the *Authorised Betting Operations Act 2000* may cause that persons fingerprints to be taken.

It is the responsibility of the person seeking approval to contact the Police Licensing Enforcement Branch. This appointment can only be made after the application has been lodged with the Office of Consumer and Business Services.
