

Public Warning Notice

Issued under section 223 of the *Australian Consumer Law (SA)*

Samuel Wayne Baligac trading as Balco Transportable

The Commissioner for Consumer Affairs is issuing a public warning notice to warn consumers not to deal with a trader by the name of Samuel Wayne Baligac trading as 'Balco Transportable'.

Consumer and Business Services (CBS) have received a number of complaints from consumers within SA who have entered into contracts with Balco Transportable for transportable buildings, paid significant deposits and not received the goods and services contracted for.

It is alleged that Balco Transportable has on a number of occasions:

1. Accepted payment for goods or services and has failed to supply all the services within a reasonable time frame in breach of section 158 (7) of the *Australian Consumer Law (SA)*.

The Commissioner is warning the public about the alleged conduct as the Commissioner:

1. has reasonable grounds to suspect that the conduct may constitute contraventions of the *Australian Consumer Law (SA)*;
2. is satisfied that one or more persons have suffered, or is likely to suffer detriment as a result of the alleged conduct; and
3. is satisfied that it is in the public interest to issue a public warning notice.
