Public Warning Notice

Issued under section 223 of the *Australian Consumer Law (SA)*

Steven Oh – Shiba Inu Breeder and Seller

The Commissioner for Consumer Affairs (“the Commissioner”) is issuing a public warning notice to warn consumers not to deal with a dog breeder by the name of Steven Oh, previously advertising as ‘Elamadoina’, breeder and seller of Shiba Inu dogs (“Steven Oh”).

Consumer and Business Services (“CBS”) has received multiple complaints from consumers who have had dealings with Steven Oh.


It is alleged that Steven Oh, on numerous occasions, has accepted payment for goods, being Shiba Inu puppies, and has failed to supply the goods in breach of section 158 of the *Australian Consumer Law (SA)*.

The Commissioner is warning the public about the alleged conduct on the basis that the Commissioner:

1. has reasonable grounds to suspect that the conduct may constitute contraventions of Chapter 4 of the *Australian Consumer Law (SA)*;
2. is satisfied that one or more persons have suffered, or is likely to suffer detriment as a result of the alleged conduct; and
3. is satisfied that it is in the public interest to issue a public warning notice.

Please be aware that Steven Oh has claimed to be part of The Master Dog Breeders & Associates (MDBA) and may attempt to continue conducting business through their website and listings.
