### Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

It is a requirement under section 97(1) of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997 (the Act) that premises must be personally supervised by a responsible person at all times that they are open to the public, however under section 97(2) of the Act the Commissioner may exempt a licensee from this requirement and approve alternative arrangements for the supervision and management of the business. An exemption can only be granted if the licensing authority is satisfied that, in view of the limited scope of a business conducted under a licence, an exemption would not compromise the principle of responsible service of alcohol and consumption of liquor.

I note that the application is for a club licence to only allow consumption on, not takeaway liquor. Although the capacity is unrestricted, in reality the Club will only host a large number of patrons during the finals series, but outside of this the number of patrons attending will be quite moderate.

I am therefore satisfied that the premises can be suitably supervised and managed through other arrangements, being that a committee member is always present when the club is trading. I grant the exemption and condition the licence accordingly.

I note that this exemption applies only to the requirement to have a responsible person present at all times, and that

the licensee must still comply with the provisions of the General Code of Practice requiring all persons involved in the sale and supply of liquor to have completed approved responsible service of alcohol training.
