### **Licence Status**

#### Suspension

The suspension of the licence is lifted, effective from 8 Sep 2022.

#### Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*. It is a requirement under section 97(1) of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act) that premises must be personally supervised by a responsible person at all times that they are open to the public.

I note that the licensee currently has an exemption from this requirement.

As part of the application for the transfer of licence, I have reviewed this exemption and asked the applicant to provide a submission if they wished for the exemption to remain on the licence.

The applicant has requested that the exemption be removed from the licence.

Under section 43 of the Act, I remove the exemption from responsible person from the licence.
