Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*. Pursuant to section 63 of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act), I am satisfied that each person who occupies a position of authority in the licensee entity is a fit and proper person to occupy such a position in the entity holding the licence.

Pursuant to section 72 of the Act, I am satisfied that the lessor has consented to the application.

The transfer application is granted effective from 5 December 2022, subject to settlement taking place on or before that date. If settlement does not take place on or before that date, the applicant must advise this office in writing of the new settlement date.

The applicant has also applied for authorisation to sell liquor in a place adjacent to the licensed premises for consumption in that area.

Prior to granting an authorisation of this kind, I must be satisfied that the object of the application could not be more appropriately achieved by redefinition of the licensed premises. I am satisfied to that fact. If the relevant place is under the control of council - council must approve the application. A copy of an outdoor dining permit from the City of Port Adelaide Enfield has been provided in support of the application.

Pursuant to section 69 of the Act, the application is granted and the place to which the authorisation relates is, when the sale of liquor is authorised, taken to form part of the licensed premises.
