## Community Impact Assessment

The application is a designated application for the purposes of section 53A of the Act.

In order to grant the application I must be satisfied that it is in the community interest to do so taking into account the harm that might be caused, the cultural, recreational, employment or tourism impacts and the social impact on the amenity of the locality. I note that the premises currently operates under a Restaurant and Catering licence, which the applicant intends to surrender should this application be granted.

Having considered the amenity and demographics of the locality, as well as the nature of the business and how it

proposes to trade, I am satisfied that this venue does not pose a greater risk of harm than any other licensed venue of this class. I also consider the fact that the licensee has been operating a licensed venue at the premises for a number of years, without issue, as a relevant factor.

I note that the locality attracts a large number of tourists and granting this application will likely benefit the Kangaroo Island Tourism industry, as well as provide another outlet for local producers to sell their liquor products to tourists visiting the area.

The applicant has also provided a number of letters of support from other Government authorities, as well as a number of private businesses operating in the area.

Having considered all the information before me, I am satisfied that the granting of this application is in the community interest.
