
In order to grant the application I must be satisfied that it is in the community interest to do so taking into account the harm that might be caused, the cultural, recreational, employment or tourism impacts and the social impact on the amenity of the locality. I note that the licensee currently operates two other licensed premises of the same name in the CBD and North Adelaide.

I am satisfied that this venue does not pose a greater risk of harm than any other venue of this nature operating in the locality. I also consider the applicant's experience in running other similar licensed premises to be relevant to this application as evidence that the applicant is familiar with all the rules and regulations pertaining to the sale and supply
