# **Community Impact Assessment**

The application is a designated application for the purposes of section 53A of the Act.

In order to grant the application I mist be satisfied that it is i the community interest to do so, taking into account the harm that might be caused, the cultural, recreational, employment or tourism impacts and the social impact on the amenity of the locality.



The application is for an entertainment business, which will include a bowling alley, augmented darts, dodgem cars, challenge rooms, amusement games, karaoke and motion simulators. The premises will also contain a full commercial kitchen and 2 bars. The premises will also host private functions and birthday parties. I note the applicant's currently operate businesses of this nature in multiple other States.

Whilst the venue will attract minors, I am satisfied that the risk of harm is quite low as the applicant intends to implement policies above and beyond what's required under the legislation, including not allowing minors on the premises after 8 pm and requiring them to be supervised by an adult at all times.

I am also satisfied that, given the number of other commercial premises in the locality, including a number who are already licensed, this application will not negatively affect the amenity of the locality, but rather add to the offerings in the CBD area.

The applicant's intend to employ around 60 staff when the premises is operating and provide an attraction in the CBD to draw locals and tourists into the area. They have consulted with nearby businesses and have received positive feedback to their proposal.

Having considered all the information before me, I am satisfied that the granting of this application is in the community interest.
