Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The applicant has addressed the objects of the Act in their application and I am satisfied the sale, supply and consumption of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public.

Pursuant to section 36(5) of the Act, a club licence may only be held by a club that is a non-profit association incorporated under the *Associations Incorporation Act 1986* or a company limited by guarantee under the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth). The applicant has provided a Certificate of Incorporation (A2229) and I am satisfied the applicant is a non-profit association incorporated under the Associations Act. The association's constitution has been provided.

Pursuant to section 56 of the Act, the applicant has provided the licensing authority with the composition of the association's committee of management and no information has been received from SA Police to indicate the members of the committee are not fit and proper persons to hold such positions.

Pursuant to section 57 of the Act, I am satisfied the premises for which the licence is sought are of a sufficient standard for the purpose of carrying on business under the licence. Further, I am satisfied the operation of the licence would be unlikely to result in undue offence, annoyance, disturbance or inconvenience to people who reside, work or worship in the vicinity of the premises and or to prejudice the safety or welfare of children attending kindergarten, primary school or secondary school in the vicinity of the premises.

City of Marion Council has confirmed they have no objection to the proposed liquor licence and I am satisfied all relevant approvals, consents and exemptions are in place.

Pursuant to section 72 of the Act, I am satisfied the landlord (City of Marion) has consented to the application.

I am satisfied that the grant of the licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.
