Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

Pursuant to section 60 of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act), I am satisfied that the premises for which the licence is sought are of a sufficient standard for the purpose of carrying on business under the licence. Further, I am satisfied that the operation of the licence would be unlikely to result in undue offence, annoyance, disturbance or inconvenience to people who reside, work or worship in the vicinity of the premises and or to prejudice the safety or welfare of children attending kindergarten, primary school or secondary school in the vicinity of the premises.

Pursuant to section 63 of the Act, I am satisfied that the applicant is a fit and proper person to hold the licence.

Pursuant to section 72 of the Act, I am satisfied that the lessor has consented to the application.
