The applicant has also indicated that the service of the liquor will be monitored to ensure customers are consuming liquor responsibly. The applicant has indicated that the busienss will be run as a restaurant with the primary services being the service of food, with the service of liquor being an ancillary service and that the business will promote the responsible consumption of liquor in a family friendly environment.
