Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997.

The applicant has indicated that they will minimise the harm and the potential for harm associated with the excessive or inappropriate consumption of liquor by ensuring that all staff that serve liquor will complete a responsible service of alcohol course which will give staff the requisite knowledge of how to minimise harm and associated harm from the excessive or inappropriate consumption of liquor. Further, the applicant has indicated that the venue will not promote excess drinking, as its primary purpose is the service of food. The applicant has indicated that they will ensure that the sale, supply and consumption of liquor is undertaken safely and responsibly by ensuring that liquor will only be sold and supplied to people after they have had their identification checked to ensure they are not a minor. The applicant has also indicated that the service of the liquor will be monitored to ensure customers are consuming liquor responsibly. The applicant has indicated that the business will be run as a restaurant with the primary services being the service of food, with the service of liquor being an ancillary service and that the business will promote the responsible consumption of liquor in a family friendly environment.
