## Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The licensed area is outlined in red on the approved plan.

I note that the business operates from a kiosk tenancy in the centre of the mall, with an adjacent seating area either side of the kiosk. A further seating area is located external to the shopping centre building a short distance from the kiosk.

The applicant has provided a copy of the lease document which provides for the licensee's use of the seating areas. The licensed area shown on the plan incorporates the three seating areas and the kiosk together into one licensed area.

Under a Restaurant and Catering licence, patrons may only consume liquor while seated at a table, unless attending a function where food is provided by the licensee. Therefore, liquor should only be consumed in the seating areas. I am satisfied that the applicant will actively manage the consumption of liquor in those areas.
