Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The application is for the grant of a restaurant and catering licence. The applicant has addressed the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act) in their application and I am satisfied that the sale, supply and consumption of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public. The applicant has indicated that liquor will only be served by personnel who have completed their Responsible Service of Alcohol training and that liquor will be appropriately stored. I am satisfied that the sale and supply of liquor will occur in a manner that minimises the harm and potential for harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of liquor.

I am satisfied that the grant of the licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.

Pursuant to section 56 of the Act, I am satisfied that each person who occupies a position of authority in the licensee entities is a fit and proper person to occupy such a position in the entities holding the licence.

Pursuant to section 57 of the Act, I am satisfied that the premises for which the licence is sought are of a sufficient standard for the purpose of carrying on business under the licence. Further, I am satisfied that the operation of the licence would be unlikely to result in undue offence, annoyance, disturbance or inconvenience to people who reside, work or worship in the vicinity of the premises and or to prejudice the safety or welfare of children attending kindergarten, primary school or secondary school in the vicinity of the premises.

Pursuant to section 72 of the Act, I am satisfied that the lessor has consented to the application.

The application is granted.
