

Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997.

I note that the licensee currently has an exemption from the responsible person requirements under section 97 of the Act. As part of the variation to conditions it is prudent to also review whether this exemption is still appropriate under the new trading rights.

I have considered the variations sought as part of this application, and how this will alter the way that the premises trades, and am satisfied that the business conducted will still be of a limited scope and therefore that the exemption can remain on the licence. I note that the capacity of the premises is quite low, at only 40 persons, and the trading hours are also minimal, compared to other businesses operating under this type of licence; there will be no late night trading under the licence.

Should further variations to the trading rights under the licence be sought, this exemption will be subject to another review.
