Transfer

The licence is transferred to Ramon Group Pty Ltd effective from 17 Mar 2022.

The following exemptions are added to the licence

- Responsible Person

Conditions

The following conditions are added to the licence

- The exemption from the Responsible Person requirements is granted on the condition that a Director of the licensee company must be contactable by phone at all times the premises is open for trade.

The following conditions are removed from the licence

- The sale of liquor by direct sales transactions is limited to the licensee's product only, except where the sale is by wholesale or where liquor is sold in an aggregate quantity of 4.5 litres or more.

Licence Status

Suspension

The suspension of the licence is lifted, effective from 17 Mar 2022.

Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

I remove the condition, as outlined above, as it is no longer required as these restrictions are now captured in the Liquor Licensing Act.
