Reasons for Decision

The licensee was previously granted an exemption from the responsible person requirements under section 97 of the Act. Whenever a licence is varied it is prudent to review whether it is still appropriate for the licensee to have this exemption in light of their new trading rights. The licensee has applied to vary their trading hours from 10pm to midnight on Thursday to Sunday,

The licensee indicated that they are willing to have a condition added to their licence that a licensee must be contactable by phone at all times they are open for trade, in order to retain this exemption. I consider this an appropriate mechanism to balance the small increase to risk that has been created by increasing their trading hours to midnight three days a week.
