Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The variation of licence conditions has prompted a review of the exemption from the responsible person requirements that was granted to the licensee. As the variation sought broadens the licensees trading rights it is prudent to review whether the exemption is still appropriate in the circumstances. I note that the applicant was advised of the review, however as they have approved responsible persons on staff they have opted not to lodge a submission as to why it should remain and accordingly the exemption is removed from the licence.
