## Premises

### Capacity

The capacity of the venue is set at 75.

### Alterations/Redefinition

I approve the proposed redefinition to the premises to include a deck and the adjacent lawns as a function centre and include a temporary marquee in accordance with the plan lodged with the application. By 3 May 2023, the applicant must provide a development approval plus confirmation the additional area is approved for occupancy and use, at which time a further order will be made and the final approved plan and licence will be issued.

- The trading hours are extended to 10:00am to Midnight on days preceding a public holiday.

## Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.  
Planning approval has been provided by the Barossa Council in relation to the proposed redefinition.

The trading hours for the venue are increased from 11am to 4pm on Friday to Sunday only, to the approved hours above, noting the sale of liquor in the cellar door area, on all days, is only permitted between 10am and 6pm (pursuant to the development approval for the venue).
