### Procedural

I allow the applicant to vary their application as follows:

### Requirements

The following requirements in support of the application have been satisfied:

- The application has been advertised
- All approvals, consents or exemptions have been obtained

### Premises

#### Removal

The licence is removed to: 6 Pennington Road ISLAND BEACH SA 5222. The licensed area is outlined in red on the approved plan.

### Conditions

#### The following conditions are added to the licence

• The licensee shall not, as part of, or in connection with, the business authorised by this licence, invite or admit prospective purchasers of liquor to the licensed premises.



### Authorisations

#### The following authorisations/restrictions are added to the licence

• Sale of liquor restricted to the licensee's own product by direct sales transactions only

### The following authorisations/restrictions are removed from the licence

- Sale of liquor by direct sales transactions and the sale of liquor for consumption off the licensed premises, other than to residents, restricted to the licensee's product only
- Sale of liquor for consumption on the licensed premises authorised but, other than to residents, is restricted to sampling only

## **Reasons for Decision**

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

As the applicant has confirmed there will be no access by the general public to the proposed premises and that sales will occur on line only, I will vary the conditions/authorisations of the licence.

I impose the following conditions/authorisations on the licence:

- Sale of liquor restricted to the licensee's own product by direct sales transactions only
- The licensee shall not, as part of, or in connection with, the business authorised by this licence, invite or admit prospective purchasers of liquor to the licensed premises

The following authorisations are removed from the licence:

- Sale of liquor by direct sales transactions and the sale of liquor for consumption off the licensed premises, other than to residents, restricted to the licensee's product only
- Sale of liquor for consumption on the licensed premises authorised but, other than to residents, is restricted to sampling only
