Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997.

It is a requirement under section 97(1) of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act) that premises must be personally



supervised by a responsible person at all times that they are open to the public, however under section 97(2) of the Act the Commissioner may exempt a licensee from this requirement and approve alternative arrangements for the supervision and management of the business.

I note that the licensee currently has an exemption from this requirement.

As part of the applications, I have reviewed this exemption and asked the applicant to provide a submission as to why the exemption should remain on the licence. The applicant has asked that the exemption be removed from the licence as it is not required. The licence is updated accordingly.
