The following conditions are added to the licence

- The licence authorises the sale of liquor produced by the licensee either personally or under contract. Details of all contracts entered into must be available for inspection by an authorised officer.

The following conditions are removed from the licence

- The exemption from the Responsible Person requirements is granted on the condition that a Director of the licensee company must be contactable by phone at all times the premises is open for trade.
- The sale of liquor by direct sales transactions is limited to the licensees product only, except where the sale is by wholesale or where liquor is sold in an aggregate quantity of 4.5 litres or more.
