Conditions

The following conditions are added to the licence

• The licensee shall not, as part of, or in connection with, the business authorised by this licence, invite or admit prospective purchasers of liquor to the licensed premises.

Authorisations

The following authorisations/restrictions are added to the licence

• Sale of liquor restricted to sale by direct sales transactions only

The following authorisations/restrictions are removed from the licence

- Sale of liquor by direct sales transactions and the sale of liquor for consumption off the licensed premises, other than to residents, restricted to the licensee's product only
- Sale of liquor for consumption on the licensed premises authorised but, other than to residents, is restricted to sampling only

Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

I note that the licensee was previously restricted to selling their own product through direct sales transactions and sampling only. As part of the application they have advised that they will not have customers attending the premises, and therefore do not require authorisation to provide samples.

In relation to selling liquor through direct sales transactions, by removing the restriction that it is only their own product that they can sell through direct sales transactions, the licensee can now sell other products through wholesale Date of Order: 24 March, 2022 Order Number: B240655 Page 1 of 2 (to other liquor merchants), or in aggregate quantities of 4.5L or more by retail to the general public. I note, however that under section 39(4a) of the Act that at least 90% of the licensee's gross turnover from the sale of liquor (excluding the licensee' own product) must be derived from the sale of liquor by wholesale.
