I exercise my discretion to determine this matter without holding a hearing.

The submission raises concerns in relation to insufficient car parking in the area and increase in traffic which would lead to annoyance and disturbance to those who live nearby.

I note that the applicant has applied for a licence which will be restricted to direct sales transactions only, being sales conducted through electronic communication (i.e. online or by phone) and not in person. This means that customers will not be permitted to attend the premises to make a purchase.

Further the licence will be subject to a condition prohibiting purchasers from attending any premises where liquor is stored or displayed by the licensee, which will ensure customers do not attend the premises to collect their purchasers.

As the licence will prohibit customers attending the premises for any reason, I do not foresee the concerns raised by Ms Fox eventuating. I therefore do not see any reason why the application should not be granted, and determine to grant the application subject to the conditions and restrictions outlined below.

Conditions

The following conditions are added to the licence

- The licensee shall not, as part of, or in connection with, the business authorised by this licence, invite or admit prospective purchasers of liquor to any premises or place at which liquor is displayed or stored by the licensee.
- The licence authorises the sale of liquor produced by the licensee either personally or under contract. Details of all contracts entered into must be available for inspection by an authorised officer.
- The licensee is authorised to despatch liquor from premises other than the licensed premises. Details of despatch sites must be made available for inspection by an authorised officer.

Authorisations

• Sale of liquor restricted to the licensee's own product by direct sales transactions only
