## Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997.
The application is for the grant of a packaged liquor sales licence restricted to sale by direct sales transactions only. The applicant has noted: I will only be purchasing small amounts unless a good business purchase order can be arranged, and some products may only be a one-of available product and this alcoholic product line range is only one product line amongst all of my other non alcoholic products for my online only e-commerce business.

The applicant has addressed the objects of the Act in their application and I am satisfied that the sale and supply of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public.

The applicant has a history of low grade offending, including alcohol related driving offences, but addressed this history
thoroughly in a response to the licensing authority. Pursuant to section 56 of the Act, I am satisfied the applicant is a fit and proper person to hold the licence.

Pursuant to section 57 (3) of the Act, I dispense with the requirement the applicant satisfy the licensing authority as to matters referred to in that section.

I am satisfied the grant of this licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.
