## Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The application is for the grant of a packaged liquor sales licence restricted to sale by direct sales transactions only. The applicant is looking to expand a small family owned food and beverage distribution company by adding alcoholic beverages. The applicant is in the process of sourcing a number of Australian made products for sale.

The applicant has addressed the objects of the Act in their application and I am satisfied that the sale and supply of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption

of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public.

Pursuant to section 57(3) of the Act, I dispense with the requirement the applicant satisfy the licensing authority as to matters referred to in that section.

I am satisfied the grant of this licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.
