Gaming Machines Regulations 2020

Regulation 11 Notice – Results of Trading Round 22/2022

The Liquor and Gambling Commissioner has determined the results of **Trading Round 22/2022** for the purchase and sale of gaming machine entitlements, held at Consumer and Business Services, 95 Grenfell Street, Adelaide SA 5000 on Wednesday 16 November 2022.

Purchaser Price *(the amount that eligible purchasers will pay)* **\$40,000.00** (plus GST)

Vendor Price *(the amount that eligible sellers will receive)* **\$30,000.00** (plus GST)

This trading round attracted a total of 140 eligible offers to purchase gaming machine entitlements and 98 eligible offers to sell gaming machine entitlements.

9 Gaming Machine Entitlements Will Be Cancelled

*Every fourth gaming machine entitlement sold in the trading round by profit organisations
(e.g. hotels) must be cancelled*

10 Gaming Machine Entitlements Will Transfer to Club One

*Every fourth gaming machine entitlement taken to have been sold in the trading round by
non-profit associations (e.g. clubs and community hotels) must be transferred to Club One*

Next Trading Round

Notice of the next trading round for gaming machine entitlements will be announced by the Commissioner in a notice published in the Government Gazette. Gaming machine licence holders will also be advised.
