

Reduction of Short-Term Liquor Licence Fees

Adelaide Fringe Discount

During the official Adelaide Fringe period, the fee for events held entirely within that period by eligible applicants will be capped for eligible events (the Adelaide Fringe discount).

The cap applies to the application fee and any applicable daily fees.

Eligibility:

Permanent licence holders:

Permanent licence holders who are hosting an Adelaide Fringe event on or adjacent to their permanently licensed premises are entitled to the Adelaide Fringe discount if their event:

- > falls wholly within the Adelaide Fringe period;
- > does not trade in liquor past 2:00am;
- > does not exceed a capacity of 1,200 people at any one time; and
- > does not have prescribed entertainment.

Other:

All other persons hosting an Adelaide Fringe event are entitled to the Adelaide Fringe discount if their event:

- > falls wholly within the Adelaide Fringe period;
- > does not trade in liquor past 2:00am;
- > does not exceed a capacity of 200 people at any one time; and
- > does not have prescribed entertainment.

Please note:

The rules relating to short term liquor licence applications, including lodgement timeframes, continue to apply. However, in 2020, the late fee that would otherwise apply to short-term liquor licence applications not lodged within the requisite timeframe will be waived for applicants eligible for the Adelaide Fringe discount.
