

Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence Fees

Short-Term Fee Reduction

This policy applies to persons who:

- > are granted a Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence;
- > applied for the Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence between 18 November 2019 and 29 February 2020; and
- > applied for and were granted short-term liquor licences for events held within the Eligible Period that would have otherwise been endorsed on their Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence had it been granted (Eligible Short-Term Liquor Licences).

Late Fee Refund:

Any late fees paid in relation to Eligible Short-Term Liquor Licences will be refunded in full following the grant of the Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence.

Short-Term Liquor Licence Partial Refund:

On the grant of the Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence, the difference between the cost of an endorsement on a Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence and the fees associated with an application for Eligible Short-Term Liquor Licences will be refunded (see table below):

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the refunds, the licensee of the Eligible Short-Term Liquor Licences must be the same licensee as on the Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence.

Eligible Period:

Class	From	To*
1	18 November 2019	Up to 17 days after the grant of the Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence
2	18 November 2019	Up to 40 days after the grant of the Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence
3	18 November 2019	Up to 70 days after the grant of the Five-Year Short-Term Liquor Licence

*Additional time has been included to allow you to apply for short term licences, without incurring late fees or additional costs, while your five-year short-term licence application is being processed.
