

Notified Requirements Ticket-In Ticket-Out (TITO)

Effective 30 July 2020

Casino Act 1997

The following notified TITO (ticket-in ticket-out) requirements have been published by the Liquor and Gambling Commissioner for the purposes of Schedule 3 of the Casino Regulations 2013.

From 28 September 2020, the holder of the casino licence may provide a gaming machine or automated table game equipment on the licensed premises that may be operated by the insertion of a banknote or by ticket (known as “ticket-in ticket-out” or TITO) subject to various transactional limits.

To facilitate the approval and installation of equipment which will be required to allow gaming machines to be operated by the insertion of banknotes or TITO, the Gaming Machines Regulations 2020 have been amended to include a bank note acceptor and any device that allows the printing or issue of tickets for use in connection with a gaming machine, as prescribed components.

A gaming machine or automated table game equipment that is intended to be operated in connection with a TITO system at the Adelaide Casino must, until 3 December 2020, be able to be operated in accordance with the TITO technical requirements set out in Schedule 4 of the Casino Regulations 2020.

From 3 December 2020 these TITO technical requirements will be replaced with Gambling Administration Guidelines issued by the Liquor and Gambling Commissioner in accordance with section 17 of the *Gambling Administration Act 2019*.
