

## Public Warning Notice

Issued under section 48 of the *Fair Trading Act 1987* (SA)

### Daniel John Pittaway trading as 'Dannyway Customs'

The Commissioner for Consumer Affairs is issuing a public warning notice to warn consumers not to deal with a trader by the name of Daniel John Pittaway trading as 'Dannyway Customs'.

Consumer and Business Services (CBS) have received a number of complaints from consumers who have had dealings with Daniel Pittaway.


It is alleged that Daniel Pittaway contracted with consumers to supply and build custom trailers, mainly for the transport of vehicles. After accepting payment and agreeing to a delivery timeframe of about 3 to 4 months, Daniel Pittaway failed to deliver the trailers within a timely manner. Consumers reported delays of up to 12 months and upon delivery, consumers found the trailers were of poor quality.

CBS had three trailers built by Daniel Pittaway inspected by the Department of Infrastructure and Transport and all were found to have a series of faults rendering them un-roadworthy and unable to be economically repaired.

The Commissioner is satisfied that Daniel Pittaway has on a number of occasions supplied goods that are unsatisfactory or dangerous. The Commissioner is warning the public about Daniel Pittaway's alleged conduct as the Commissioner:

1. has reasonable grounds to suspect that the goods supplied are unsafe; and
2. is satisfied that one or more persons have suffered, or is likely to suffer detriment as a result of the alleged conduct; and
3. is satisfied that it is in the public interest to issue a public warning notice.
