

Business Criteria

Contractors: companies and individuals

Plumbers Gas Fitters and Electricians Act 1995

Security and Investigation Industry Act 1995

To meet the business knowledge and experience requirements to be granted a contractor's licence (plumber, gas fitter, electrician), or a security/investigation agent's licence, you, as a director of a body corporate, must meet one of the options below.

Copies of requested documents must be submitted. Original documents will not be returned.

If you believe you have equivalent knowledge, you can have this assessed by contacting any registered training organisation that delivers an approved qualification and seek Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for that qualification.

Option 1

You currently hold a contractor licence under the *Building Work Contractors Act 1995*, *Plumbers, Gas Fitters and Electricians Act 1995* or *Security and Investigation Industry Act 1995*, which authorises you to carry on business as a sole trader or as a sole director.

OR

You previously held an occupational licence (in relation to the Acts above) which authorised you to carry on business in South Australia. This licence may have been cancelled or surrendered. **Consumer and Business Services (CBS) may require additional information or the full business criteria.**

OR

Hold a current equivalent interstate occupational licence in the same jurisdiction as the South Australian licence.

Option 2

Successful completion in one unit from **Category A** and one from **Category B** issued by a registered training organisation:

Category A:

- BSBSMB401 - Establish legal and risk management requirements of small business
- BSBESB402 - Establish legal and risk management requirements of a business venture or new business venture.

Additional options for Plumbers, Gas Fitters and Electricians ONLY:

- BCGBC4009A - Apply legal requirements to building and construction projects or
- CPCCBC4009A - Apply legal requirements to building and construction projects or
- CPCCBC4009B - Apply legal requirements to building and construction projects

AND

Category B:

- BSBSMB402 - Plan small business finances or
- BSBESB403 - Plan finances for new business ventures or
- BSBSMB406 - Manage small business finances or
- BSBSMB404 - Undertake small business planning or
- BSBESB401 - Research and develop business plans.

Option 3

Successful completion of one of the following 2 units issued by a registered training organisation:

- PRSSM507A - Develop and implement a business plan.

OR

- BSBMGT617A - Develop and implement a business plan or
- BSBOPS601 - Develop and implement business plans.

Option 4

Successful completion of a business, economics or accounting related Degree or Diploma from Australia or New Zealand.

You must also provide a transcript of completed subjects showing evidence of completed competencies related to the practical aspects of running a business demonstrating sufficient financial and legal knowledge in particular.

Please note, a Certificate IV is not accepted.

Option 5

Successful completion of Bachelor of Built Environment issued by the University of South Australia.

Option 6

Successful completion of these 4 modules of the Certificate IV in Small Business Management:

- Cost profit breakeven
- Business finance
- Ownership structures
- Business law

Option 7

The applicant is a company listed on the Australian Stock Exchange or a subsidiary of a listed company.

Option 8 (for Plumbers, Gasfitters & Electricians ONLY)

One of the following approved qualifications:

- Contractors Management Program Certificate IV Diploma in Building - with academic record
- Certificate IV in Building - with academic record
- Business Management for Building 1 (AQF4) & Business Management for Building 2 (AQF5) - with academic record.

A contractor licence is dependent upon completion of specific modules of the above courses. For details of the specified modules and sections please contact CBS.

Option 9 (for Plumbers, Gasfitters, Electricians ONLY)

- Successful completion of a Bachelor of Construction Management & Economics degree
