Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The application is for the grant of an on premises licence, the premises to which relates to a public conveyance.

As part of their application, the applicant has addressed the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act) and I am satisfied that the sale, supply and consumption of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public.

I am satisfied that the grant of the licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.

Pursuant to section 56 of the Act, I am satisfied that Ms Laura Bennett, who has applied to be the licensee, is a fit and proper person to hold the licence.

The applicant has provided the licensing authority with a copy of a Vehicle Identity Inspection Report indicating that the vehicle (registration number IGZU055) passed a vehicle inspection on 14 May 2021. Pursuant to section 57 of the Act, I am satisfied that the premises is of a sufficient standard for the purpose of carrying on business under the licence.

The application is granted.
