## Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The licensee has applied to remove their licensed premises to 1 McGilton Road, Berri SA 5073.

In support of their application, the licensee has provided a copy of the Decision Notification Form dated 20 May 2019 indicating that both the Development Plan Consent and the Building Rules Consent had been granted, a Certificate of Occupancy specifying that the building to which the licence is being removed is suitable for occupation and a letter from the Berri Barmera Council indicating that the Council has no objection to the RSL Berri Sub Branch removing their licence to 1 McGilton Road, Berri., Pursuant to section 60(1) of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act), I am satisfied that the premises to which removal of the licence is sought are of an appropriate standard for carrying on business under the licence and that the removal of the licence is unlikely to result in undue offence, annoyance, disturbance or inconvenience to people who reside, work or worship in the vicinity of the premises or prejudice the safety or welfare of children attending kindergarten, primary school or secondary school in the vicinity of the premises

Pursuant to section 60(2) of the Act, I am satisfied that all approvals, consents and exemptions required under the law

relating to planning to permit the use of the premises for the sale of liquor have been obtained and that any other relevant approvals, consents and exemptions required for carrying on the business from the premises have been obtained.

The removal application is granted.
