Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The application is for the grant of a liquor production and sales licence in Port Elliot, a popular tourist town. The applicant has addressed the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act) in their application and I am satisfied that the sale, supply and consumption of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public. The applicant has indicated that all persons in a position of authority within the licensee company will complete responsible service of alcohol course, as will all employees and I am satisfied that the sale and supply of liquor will occur in a manner that minimises the harm and potential for harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of liquor.

I am satisfied that the grant of the licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.

The application is granted.
