Conditions

The following conditions are added to the licence

- The licence authorises the sale of liquor produced by the licensee either personally or under contract. Details of all contracts entered into must be available for inspection by an authorised officer.

Authorisations

The following authorisations/restrictions are added to the licence

- Sale of liquor by direct sales transactions and the sale of liquor for consumption off the licensed premises restricted to the licensee's product only
- Sale of liquor for consumption on the licensed premises authorised

Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The application is for the grant of a liquor production and sales licence which allows the consumption of liquor on the premises and is restricted to the sale of liquor for consumption off and by direct sales transactions to the licensee's product. The applicant has addressed the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act) in their application and I am satisfied that the sale, supply and consumption of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public.

I am satisfied that the grant of the licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.

Pursuant to section 56 of the Act, I am satisfied that all persons who occupy a position of authority in the entity holding the licence, are fit and proper persons to occupy such a position.

Pursuant to section 57 of the Act, I am satisfied that the premises for which the licence is sought are of a sufficient standard for the purpose of carrying on business under the licence. Further, I am satisfied that the operation of the licence would be unlikely to result in undue offence, annoyance, disturbance or inconvenience to people who reside, work or worship in the vicinity of the premises and or to prejudice the safety or welfare of children attending kindergarten, primary school or secondary school in the vicinity of the premises. I note that Renmark Paringa Council have indicated that they do not have any concerns with the grant of the licence.

I also note the existence of another liquor licence at the same address – Rustons Distillery (57619258). I am satisfied that there is no overlap of the two premises and that section 48 of the Act would not be offended by the grant of this licence.

The application is granted.
