Conditions

The following conditions are added to the licence

- Any delivery agreements and despatch sites must be made available for inspection by an authorised officer.
- The licensee shall not, as part of, or in connection with, the business authorised by this licence, invite or admit prospective purchasers of liquor to any premises or place at which liquor is displayed or stored by the licensee.

Authorisations

The following authorisations/restrictions are added to the licence

- Sale of liquor restricted to sale by direct sales transactions only

Reasons for Decision

In reaching my determination, I have had regard to the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*.

The application is for the grant of a packaged liquor sales licence which is restricted to sale by direct sales transactions

only. The applicant has addressed the objects of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act) in their application and I am satisfied that the sale, supply and consumption of liquor will be undertaken safely and responsibly, consistent with the principle of responsible service and consumption of liquor and the expectations and aspirations of the public. The applicant is reminded that the minimisation of harm associated with the excessive or inappropriate consumption of liquor extends to the sale of liquor for consumption off the licensed premises and is encouraged to implement practices that ensure that the potential for harm associated with the excessive or inappropriate consumption of liquor is minimised.

I am satisfied that the grant of the licence would not be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the objects of the Act.

Pursuant to section 56 of the Act, I am satisfied that the applicants are fit and proper persons to hold the licence.

Pursuant to section 57 of the Act, I dispense with the requirement that the applicant satisfy the licensing authority as to any matter referred to in that section.

The application is granted subject to the abovementioned conditions and authorisations.
