2 Step Qualifications Guidelines

Plumbers, Gas Fitters and Electricians Act 1995

For course requirements relating to domestic electrical work please refer to the Electrical Qualification guidelines.

Step 1

To be eligible for an “**under supervision**” **restricted** electrical worker’s registration endorsed for:

- *Disconnection/reconnection of permanently connected commercial or industrial electrical equipment; cannot install or alter repair or maintain fixed wiring;*

You must supply evidence meeting **one** of the pathways listed below:

Pathway 1 - A certificate III or higher level qualification in a trade or vocation that relates to the work to be performed.

Pathway 2 - A trade certificate or equivalent in a trade that relates to the work to be performed.

Pathway 3 - A academic statement, or statement of attainment showing successful completion of:

Step 2

To be eligible to **remove the “under supervision”** condition you must provide evidence of successful completion in **one** of the following units:

UEENEOP001A - Disconnect and reconnect fixed wired electrical equipment connected to a low voltage supply	UEENEOP001B - Disconnect and reconnect fixed wired electrical equipment connected to a low voltage supply
UEENEOP011A - Disconnect - reconnect neon signs connected to low voltage installation wiring	UEENEOP010A - Disconnect - reconnect appliances connected to low voltage installation wiring
UEENEOP013A - Disconnect - reconnect control devices connected to low voltage installation wiring	UEENEOP012A - Disconnect - reconnect composite appliances connected to low voltage installation wiring
UEENEOP015A - Disconnect - reconnect motors connected to low voltage installation wiring	UEENEOP014A - Disconnect - reconnect water heaters connected to low voltage installation wiring
UEERL0004 - Disconnect - reconnect electrical equipment connected to low voltage (LV) installation wiring
