

Signage requirements for gaming areas

(A) - Perimeter Sign

For display at each entrance to a gaming area
Size = A3 equivalent

GCOP Clause 45(1)



(B) - Multilingual Sign

For display in a prominent position in each gaming area
Size = A3 equivalent

GCOP Clause 45(3)



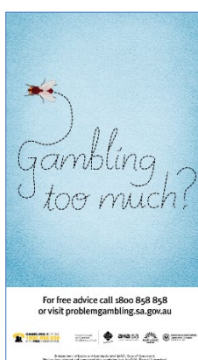
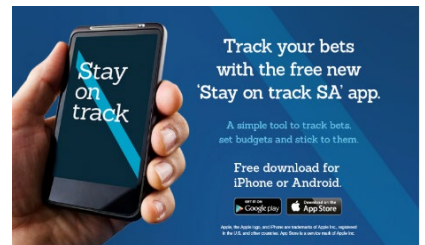
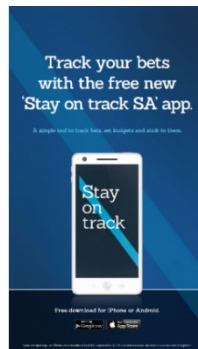
(C) - OPG Approved Responsible Gambling Messages

Any of the signs shown or a combination of, for use on:

- Automatic Teller Machines (ATM)
- EFTPOS (fitted with touch screen enabled devices)

Displayed on full screen

GCOP Clause 45A(1)(a)



(D) - Condensed warning message and national gambling helpline number

For prominent display on or near:

- each automated coin dispensing machine
- each cashier area

(Example developed by AHA and Clubs SA)

GCOP Clause 45A(2)(a)



(E) - National Gambling Helpline Card

For availability at or near:

- each ATM and EFTPOS facility located on the premises
- each automated coin dispensing machine
- each customer service point where money is exchanged
- each gaming machine

Size must be approximately 90mm x 50mm

GCOP Clause 45A(2)(b) and Clause 50(1)(c)



(G) - UBET SA combined areas poster

Incorporating:

- governed by code of practice
- multilingual responsible gambling poster

GCOP Clause 50(1)(b) and Clause 50(2)(b)



(F) - OPG approved responsible gambling materials

Any of the signs shown or a combination of, for display in gaming areas as signage. Venues are strongly encouraged to replace some existing messaging with the new "Please don't be offended" messaging.
